

## George Watson College Edinburgh dramatic improvements with Elmo LN1 Visualiser



### Background

George Watson's College is a fully integrated school, catering for girls and boys from Nursery through to Senior 6 on a single campus just to the south of Edinburgh's City Centre. Throughout the School's long history, there have been many changes. In line with these changes and modern developments they choose the Elmo visualiser to improve the teaching environment, adding quality to the day to day learning and teaching.

### Solution

The Elmo Visualiser has dramatically altered the way the lessons are taught, they can be pre-prepared and a lot of time saved by not having to write everything on the board during lessons. Mr. Lewis Smith the ICT Director of George Watson College claimed that *"Using it to teach 3D shapes with my younger classes brought gasps of admiration and their understanding this year is so much better"*. Lessons can be saved using the SD memory card which is a great solution for students who are absent. It is a very powerful tool for assessing a piece of work.

It enables pupils to show and share their own work with others. Furthermore, pupils can sit at their allocated work stations whilst clearly observing teacher demonstrations especially in highly technical subjects.

### Outcome

Currently, the visualiser technology gets shared between classes. However everyone has been so impressed that from next session all teachers in the department will have one.
