

## AVM integrates 15 rooms at Holman Fenwick Willan with total AV and VC solution



### Background

Holman Fenwick Willan (HFW) is a global law firm, advising in all aspects of international commerce. HFW has around 300 lawyers operating from eight offices - London, Paris, Rouen, Brussels, Piraeus, Dubai, Hong Kong, Shanghai, Singapore and Melbourne.

### Solution

HFW required a conceptual and contemporary solution for their new building - within the Lower ground and Ground floor. The space required Audio Visual solutions within 15 rooms, 3 of which would incorporate Video Conferencing technology. 90% of the rooms were required to be HD ready presentational devices with DVD capability. Rooms required lighting and black out blind control systems and a link to their fire alarm system (in order to shut down all AV in the event of a fire). Many of the rooms required the ability to open up allowing for additional attendees. 15% of the rooms were future-proofed to allow for additional works.

### Outcome

AVM integrated an HD ready system that can be controlled via a local LAN – each room is fitted with a 5.7” wall mounted Crestron touch panel to control lighting, the blinds, Panasonic screens, audio and SKY TV. The reception area had a screen fitted with an NEC 46” display with speakers and a loop sound system built into the reception desk to aid people who suffer from hearing difficulties. Each AV room was fitted with a hand build rack to retro fit and match the design of the existing furniture. The Lower Ground Suite has the ability to open up into three areas to allow for larger presentations. This includes 2 repeater screens a Video Conferencing system (Polycom HD 8004), a 100” diagonal rear projection screen, table microphones, SKY and HD DVD. A lectern was provided for larger presentations.
